## Pearce shines at Harvel

ISTEAD and Ifield Harriers put up a good showing in the Harvel 5km race on Saturday.

Raymond Pearce led the club's 11-strong team home as he finished the race - won by Neil Renault - sixth in a time of 28min 33sec, with Derek George finishing just over a minute behind in 16th.

There were good performances from Steve Cable (30:29), Steve Lelliott (30:30) and Andrew Archer (30:50), while young Phillip Thompson came home in 70th position (34:47).

In 77th position was Deborah Pearce, in a time of 35:47.

Debbie's partner Raymond took part in the MV40 category and was placed 43rd out of a field of 286 in a time of 1:19.
